

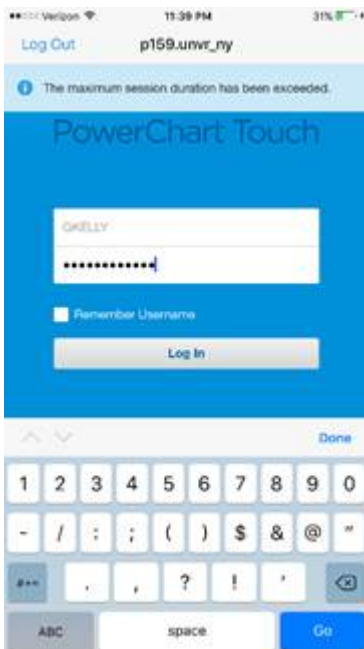

## How to use the “Powerchart Touch” iPhone App to dictate Operative Notes

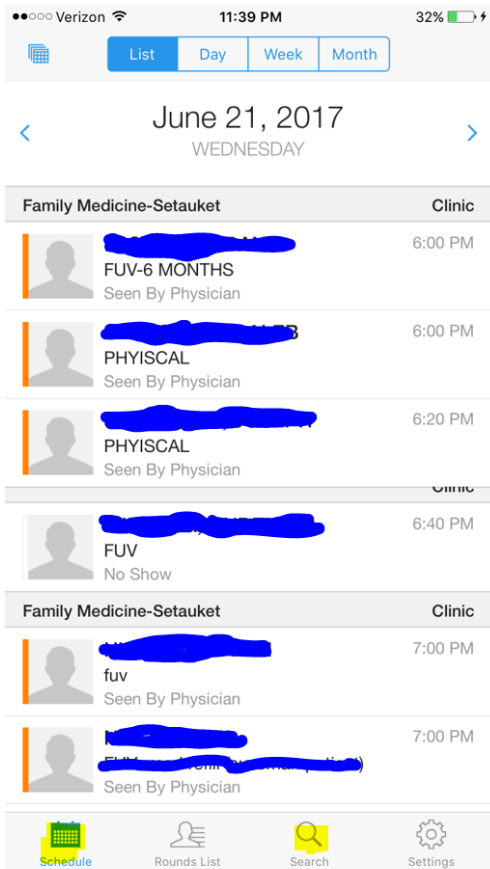
(1) Find the PowerChart App on you iPhone



(2) Sign in Using your credentials



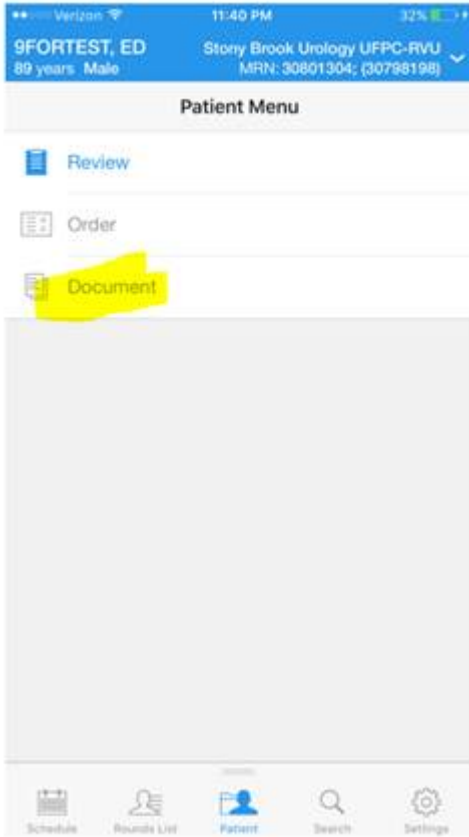
(3) Pick your patient from the list, or search. (If you search then pick the correct encounter)



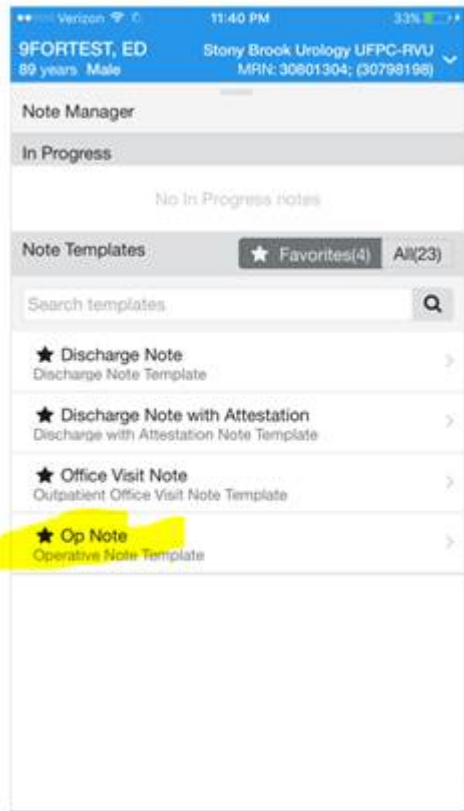
(4) Find the Review area and slide down to reveal the “Menu”  
(TIP: Touch the word “Review” and Swipe Down.)



(5) Select "Document"



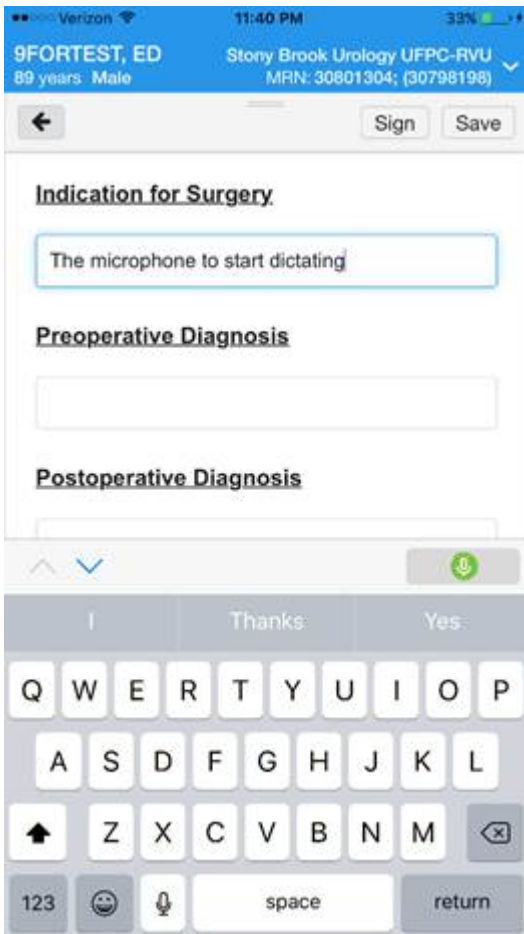
(6) Select "Op Note"



(7) Dictate into the fields, when done hit “Sign” or “Save”

(TIP: Important to use the button that is “Green” in the picture below to start/stop dictation.)

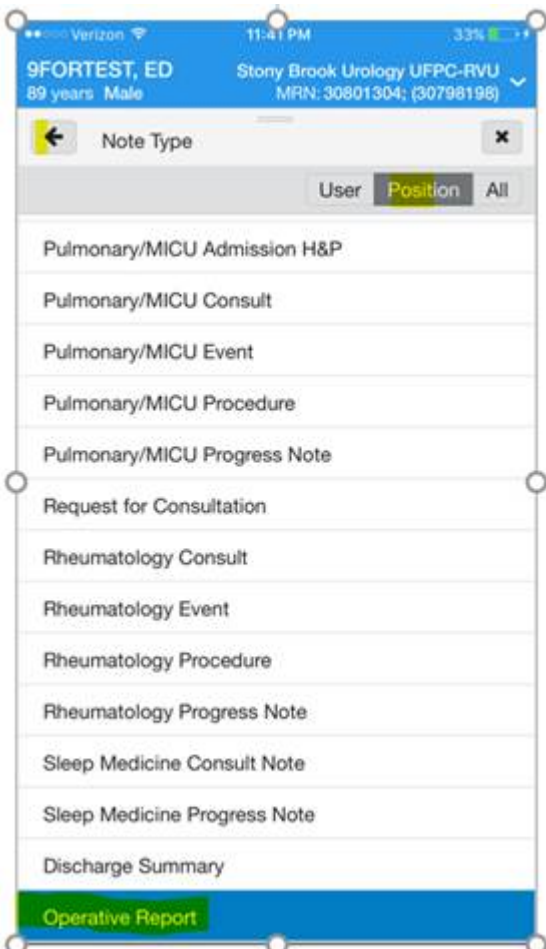
(TIP: If you “Press and Hold” the button that is “Green” in the picture below the application will list instructions for help.)



(8) Select the correct “Document Type” OPERATIVE REPORT

(TIP: If you don’t see the Note Type “Operative Report” change the toggle to “Position or “All”.

It is extremely important to select “Operative Report” otherwise the system will assign a deficiency)



(9) Go Back and click "Sign"
