How to Connect to a Stony Brook Medicine PC in Microsoft Windows 10.

Stony Brook Medicine Information Technology provides the ability to connect to your office/work computer from a personal PC or laptop when you are off-network using the Remote Desktop Connection app.

1. From our Stony Brook Medicine Remote Access portal: <u>https://apps.stonybrookmedicine.edu</u> , logon and click the Remote Desktop icon:



2. In the Remote Desktop Connection window, type the computer name or the IP address of the Windows PC that you want to connect to at your office/work location.
